- Help to establish and operate a local office near the storage field.
- Staff the local office for set hours each week.
- Participate in project calls to stay informed and contribute to discussions.
- Accompany senior team members to local meetings and presentations to provide a local perspective and presence.
- Field inquiries about the project and collaborate with the team to develop appropriate responses.
- Attend local meetings of significance to gather information and network with stakeholders.



- Represent the project at chamber and economic development organization meetings as a designated team representative.
- Identify and recommend sponsorship and donation opportunities to support community initiatives.

- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, with the ability to engage effectively with diverse stakeholders.
